The Journey Towards Judgment



For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

The Journey Towards Judgment



- God's wrath is revealed against those who suppress the truth in unrighteousness
- Outsiders can discern God's attributes through the creation (general revelation)
- People darkened their hearts in three waves of apostasy

Three waves of apostasy



- A heterosexual revolution
- A homosexual revolution
- A God-hating revolution

A heterosexual revolution



- A heterosexual revolution starts as a rejection of God's **positive** law
- Positive here means posited law
- Special revelation is rejected
- This apostasy driven through natural lusts.

A heterosexual revolution



Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things. **Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:** Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

A homosexual revolution



- A homosexual revolution starts as a rejection of God's created order
- Attributes of natural law reduced to social constructs
- General revelation is rejected
- This apostasy driven through unnatural lusts (abortion, LGBTQ, gender-fluid, etc)

A homosexual revolution



For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet.

– Rom 1:26–27

A God-hating revolution



- A God revolution starts as a total rejection of God
- God is demonized as evil
- Humanistic and occultic revelation is exalted
- This apostasy driven through urge to replace God


A God-hating revolution



And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

A God-hating revolution ends at the point of no return
