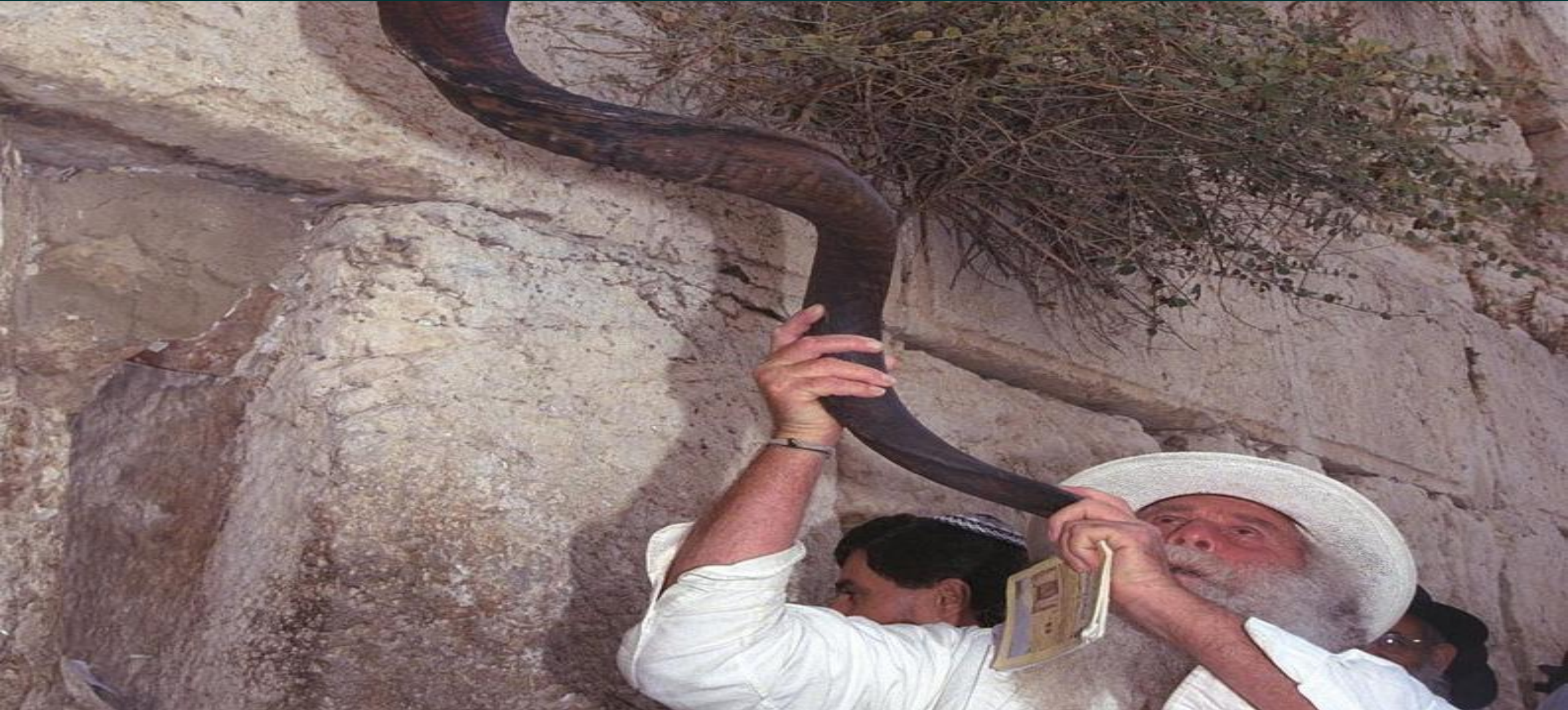



The Trumpets call


-

 - To call on the camp to move to the next step in the journey
 - To sound the alarm of war in both offense and defense

Trumpets to call Assemblies



Numbers 10:1-7 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, - 2 Make thee two trumpets of silver; of a whole piece shalt thou make them: that thou mayest use them for the calling of the assembly, and for the journeying of the camps. - 3 And when they shall blow with them, all the assembly shall assemble themselves to thee at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. - 4 And if they blow but with one trumpet, then the princes, which are heads of the thousands of Israel, shall gather themselves unto thee. - 5 When ye blow an alarm, then the camps that lie on the east parts shall go forward. - 6 When ye blow an alarm the second time, then the camps that lie on the south side shall take their journey: they shall blow an alarm for their journeys. - 7 But when the congregation is to be gathered together, ye shall blow, but ye shall not sound an alarm.

Numbers 10:9-10 | Trumpets to sound the alarm of war

And if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresseth you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall be remembered before the LORD your God, and ye shall be saved from your enemies. - 10 Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, ye shall blow with the trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; that they may be to you for a memorial before your God: I am the LORD your God.


The call the camp to move (Rapture)

Matthew 24:29-31 Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: - 30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. - 31 **And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet**, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

1 Corinthians 15:50-52 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption. - 51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, - 52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, **at the last trump**: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

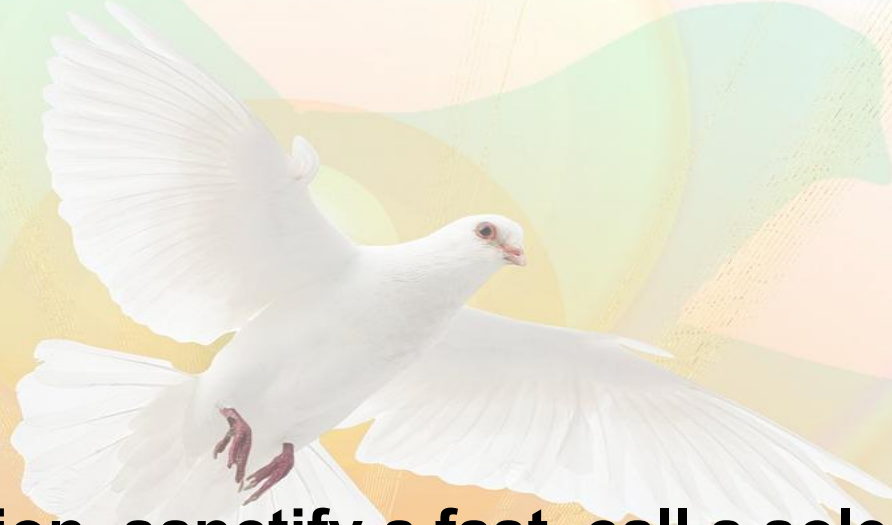
1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a **shout**, with the voice of the archangel, and with the **trump of God**: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

Joel 2:1-3 | To call assemblies to gather/war


Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the LORD cometh, for it is nigh at hand; - 2 A day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick darkness, as the morning spread upon the mountains: a great people and a strong; there hath not been ever the like, neither shall be any more after it, even to the years of many generations. - 3 A fire devoureth before them; and behind them a flame burneth: the land is as the garden of Eden before them, and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them...

Joel 2:15-17 | To call sacred assemblies



... - 15 **Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly:** - 16 Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breasts: let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet. - 17 Let the priests, the ministers of the LORD, weep between the porch and the altar, and let them say, Spare thy people, O LORD, and give not thine heritage to reproach, that the heathen should rule over them: wherefore should they say among the people, Where is their God?

Joel 2 fulfilled in Acts as the former rain



Acts 2:14-20 But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words: - 15 For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day. - 16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; - 17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: - 18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:

- 19 And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: - 20 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come:

The former and latter rain

Joel 2:23 Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month.

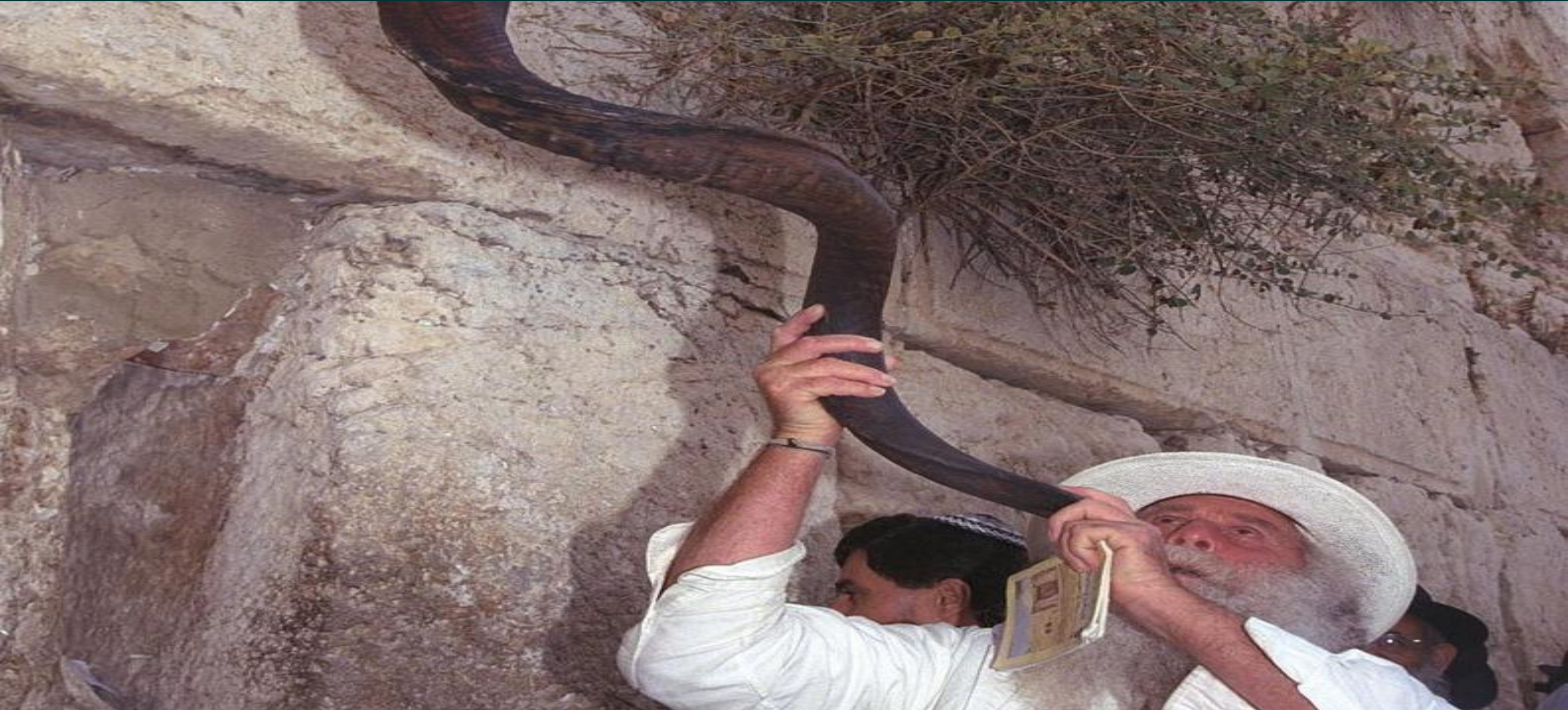
Hosea 6:3 Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth.

Hosea 10:12 Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground: for it is time to seek the LORD, till he come and rain righteousness upon you.

Zechariah 9:14-10:1 | The former and latter rain

And the LORD shall be seen over them, and his arrow shall go forth as the lightning: and **the Lord GOD shall blow the trumpet**, and shall go with whirlwinds of the south. - 15 The LORD of hosts shall defend them; and they shall devour, and subdue with sling stones; and they shall drink, and make a noise as through wine; and they shall be filled like bowls, and as the corners of the altar. - 16 And the LORD their God shall save them in that day as the flock of his people: for they shall be as the stones of a crown, lifted up as an ensign upon his land. - 17 For how great is his goodness, and how great is his beauty! corn shall make the young men cheerful, and new wine the maids. - 10:1 **Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain;** so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.
