




Psalm 144:1




2 Samuel 22:1–6



(11) And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: and he was seen upon the wings of the wind. (12) And he made darkness pavilions round about him, dark waters, and thick clouds of the skies.


2 Samuel 22:13-16




1 Peter 3:8-15

Ephesians 6:10-18







patience and the faith of the saints.**


Our Final Victory
