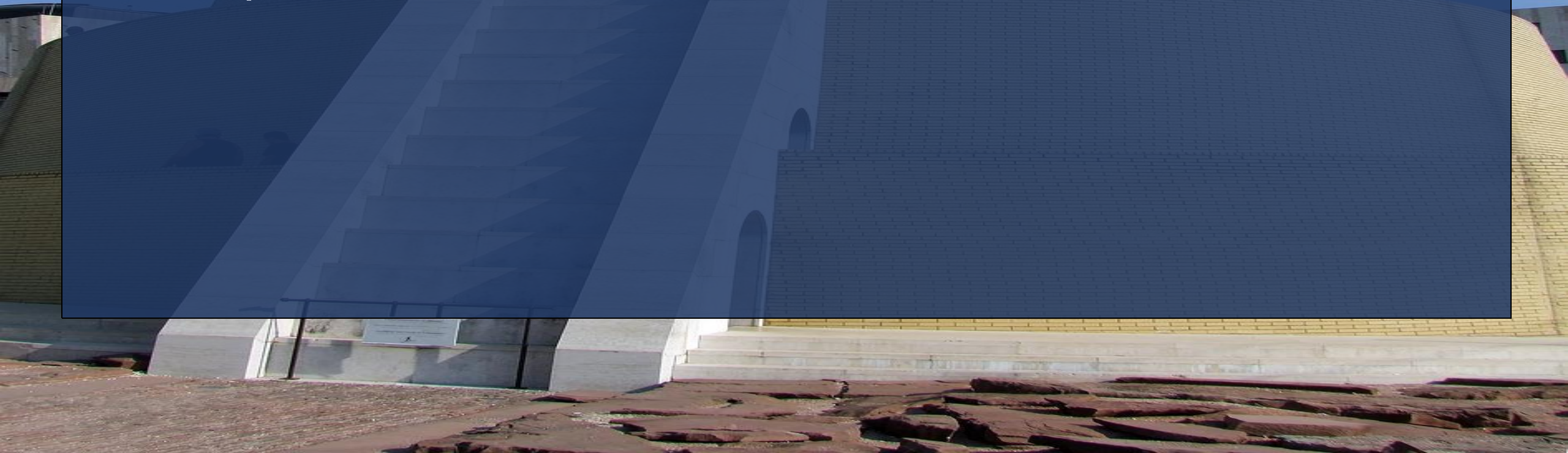

- In The New World Satan Reboots His plans for world domination

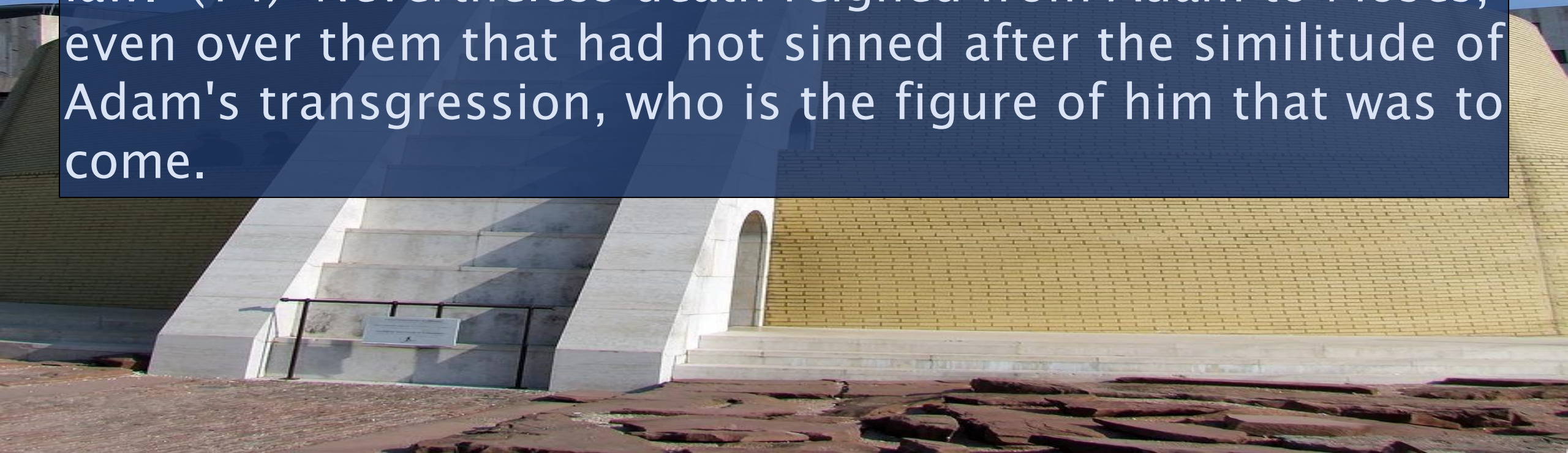
In the Old World Everyone Was Lawless

- The Law was not yet given
- People did what “was right in their own eyes.”
- People lived very long lives and became exceedingly corrupted



The Law Was Not Yet Given, So Everyone Was Lawless.

Romans 5:12–14 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: (13) (For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law. (14) Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come.



People Did What “Was Right in Their Own Eyes.”

Deut 12:8 Ye shall not do after all the things that we do here this day, every man whatsoever is right in his own eyes.

Jdg 17:6 In those days there was no king in Israel, but every man did that which was right in his own eyes.

Jdg 21:25 In those days there was no king in Israel: every man did that which was right in his own eyes.

Pro 12:15 The way of a fool is right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto counsel is wise.

Pro 21:2 Every way of a man is right in his own eyes: but the LORD pondereth the hearts.

God's Plans for the New World

- The Great Flood was a global reset.
- He reduced lifespans to minimize the corruption of the soul
- He introduced eating meat.
- He instituted human government.
- He split the world into nations by language
- He charted the broad strokes of human history
- He began to create a people – a city – for Himself

The Great Flood was a Global Reset.

2 Peter 3:3–10 Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, (4) And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation. (5) For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: (6) Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished: (7) But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men...

The Great Flood was a Global Reset.

2 Peter 3:3–10 ... (8) But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. (9) The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. (10) But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

He Introduced Eating Meat.

Genesis 9:1–4 And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth. (2) And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all that moveth upon the earth, and upon all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered. (3) Every moving thing that liveth shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things. (4) But flesh with the life thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall ye not eat.

He Instituted Human Government.

Genesis 9:5-7 And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man. (6) Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man. (7) And you, be ye fruitful, and multiply; bring forth abundantly in the earth, and multiply therein.

He Charted the Broad Strokes of Human History

Genesis 10:1–32 Now these are the generations of the sons of Noah, Shem, Ham, and Japheth: and unto them were sons born after the flood. (2) The sons of Japheth; Gomer, and Magog, and Madai, and Javan, and Tubal, and Meshech, and Tiras... ..(5) By these were the isles of the Gentiles divided in their lands; every one after his tongue, after their families, in their nations...

He Charted the Broad Strokes of Human History

Genesis 10:1–32 ... (6) And the sons of Ham; Cush, and Mizraim, and Phut, and Canaan. (7) And the sons of Cush; Seba, and Havilah, and Sabtah, and Raamah, and Sabtecha: and the sons of Raamah; Sheba, and Dedan. (8) And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one in the earth. (9) He was a mighty hunter before the LORD: wherefore it is said, Even as Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD. (10) And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, and Erech, and Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar...

He Charted the Broad Strokes of Human History

Genesis 10:1–32 ... (21) Unto Shem also, the father of all the children of Eber, the brother of Japheth the elder, even to him were children born. (22) The children of Shem; Elam, and Asshur, and Arphaxad, and Lud, and Aram...

...(32) These are the families of the sons of Noah, after their generations, in their nations: and by these were the nations divided in the earth after the flood.

He Began to Create a People – a City – for Himself

Genesis 11:10–26 These are the generations of Shem: Shem was an hundred years old, and begat Arphaxad two years after the flood: (11) And Shem lived after he begat Arphaxad five hundred years, and begat sons and daughters. (12) And Arphaxad lived five and thirty years, and begat Salah: (13) And Arphaxad lived after he begat Salah four hundred and three years, and begat sons and daughters. (14) And Salah lived thirty years, and begat Eber: (15) And Salah lived after he begat Eber four hundred and three years, and begat sons and daughters. (16) And Eber lived four and thirty years, and begat Peleg: (17) And Eber lived after he begat Peleg four hundred and thirty years, and begat sons and daughters...

He Began to Create a People – a City – for Himself

Genesis 11:10–26 ... (18) And Peleg lived thirty years, and begat Reu: (19) And Peleg lived after he begat Reu two hundred and nine years, and begat sons and daughters. (20) And Reu lived two and thirty years, and begat Serug: (21) And Reu lived after he begat Serug two hundred and seven years, and begat sons and daughters. (22) And Serug lived thirty years, and begat Nahor: (23) And Serug lived after he begat Nahor two hundred years, and begat sons and daughters. (24) And Nahor lived nine and twenty years, and begat Terah: (25) And Nahor lived after he begat Terah an hundred and nineteen years, and begat sons and daughters. (26) And Terah lived seventy years, and begat Abram, Nahor, and Haran.

He Reduced Human Lifespans to Curb Corruption

Satan Sought to Create a One World Government.

Genesis 11:1–7 And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech. (2) And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; and they dwelt there. (3) And they said one to another, Go to, let us make brick, and burn them throughly. And they had brick for stone, and slime had they for mortar. (4) And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth....

God divided people into nations
on the basis of language.

Genesis 11:1–7 ... (5) And the LORD came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men builded. (6) And the LORD said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do. (7) Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech.

Satan's Purpose

The One World Religion and One World Government Described in Revelation is Satan's Endgame

Revelation 13:1–4 And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy. (2) And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority...

The One World Religion and One World Government Described in Revelation is Satan's Endgame

Revelation 13:1-4 ... (3) And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast. (4) And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him

Revelation 21:1–5 And I saw new heavens,
and a new earth: for the former heaven and
the former earth had passed away: and the sea
was no more. 2 And I saw the holy city, the
New Jerusalem, descending from God out of
heaven, prepared like a bride adorned for her
husband...

begins an agenda that leads to God's Global Reset

Revelation 21:1–5 ...3 And I heard a great voice from heaven, which said: Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men; and he dwelleth with them: they will be his people; and God will be with them, a God to them. 4 And every tear will be wiped from their eyes; and there will no more be death, nor mourning, nor wailing; nor shall pain be any more; because the former things are passed away. 5 And He who sat on the throne, said: Behold, I make all things new. And he said: Write; because these are the faithful and true words of God.
