Matthew 2:1-6 Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, 2 saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him." 3 When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him...

Matthew 2:13-15 ...14 When he arose, he took the young Child and His mother by night and departed for Egypt, 15 and was there until the death of Herod, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying, "OUT OF EGYPT I CALLED MY SON."

Boy Genius in the Temple

Luke 2:41–47 His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover. 42 And when He was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem according to the custom of the feast. 43 When they had finished the days, as they returned, the Boy Jesus lingered behind in Jerusalem. And Joseph and His mother did not know it;...

Boy Genius in the Temple

Luke 2:41-47 ...44 but supposing Him to have been in the company, they went a day's journey, and sought Him among their relatives and acquaintances. 45 So when they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him...


Boy Genius in the Temple

Luke 2:41-47 ...46 Now so it was that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions. 47 And all who heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers.


How High was Jesus 10?

- Child IQ is mental age/physical age (30/12~= 250)
- This requires an adjustment, as Temple 'Ph.Ds' were above average (prob 130 avg | 130/100 = 1.3 multiplier)
- Adjusted IQ $(30/12) \times 1.3 \sim = 325$

Dunning-Kruger Effect




Pride Can Make One Stupid



Jesus and Dunning-Kruger

- The inflation of perceived competence is due to cognitive biases related to both human finitude and SIN
- Jesus' humanity only had cognitive biases related to human finititude
- Jesus' humanity overcame by Revelation



Jesus Dealt With Less Intelligent People

Luke 2:48-50 So when they saw Him, they were amazed; and His mother said to Him, "Son why have You done this to us? Look, Your father and I have sought You anxiously." 49 And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?" 50 But they did not understand the statement which He spoke to them.

Jesus Listened to Less Intelligent People

Luke 2:51-52 Then He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was subject to them, but His mother kept all these things in her heart. 52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.
