(11) As an eagle stirs up its nest, Hovers over its young, Spreading out its wings, taking them up, Carrying them on its wings,

# The Lord as a Mother Hen

Mat 23:37-39 "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing! (38) See! Your house is left to you desolate; (39) for I say to you, you shall see Me no more till you say, 'BLESSED is HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!' "

# Moses and the Israelites

Num 14:20–32 Then the LORD said: "I have pardoned, according to your word; (21) but truly, as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the LORD— (22) because all these men who have seen My glory and the signs which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have put Me to the test now these ten times, and have not heeded My voice, (23) they certainly shall not see the land of which I swore to their fathers, nor shall any of those who rejected Me see it..."

# Moses and the Israelites

Num 14:20-32 ... (24) But My servant Caleb, because he has a different spirit in him and has followed Me fully, I will bring into the land where he went, and his descendants shall inherit it. (25) Now the Amalekites and the Canaanites dwell in the valley; tomorrow turn and move out into the wilderness by the Way of the Red Sea." (26) And the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying, (27) "How long shall I bear with this evil congregation who complain against Me?..."

# Moses and the Israelites



Num 14:20–32 ...I have heard the complaints which the children of Israel make against Me. (28) Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you: (29) The carcasses of you who have complained against Me shall fall in this wilderness, all of you who were numbered, according to your entire number, from twenty years old and above...

# Moses and the Israelites

- No revival in Israel due to Egypt being in the Israelites.
- Endurance in the wilderness until the hard hearted fell was key.
- Younger generation trained during wilderness journeys and assumed leadership under Joshua and Caleb

# The Josiah Revival

2 Ch 34:14–21 Now when they brought out the money that was brought into the house of the LORD, Hilkiah the priest found the Book of the Law of the LORD given by Moses. (15) Then Hilkiah answered and said to Shaphan the scribe, "I have found the Book of the Law in the house of the LORD." And Hilkiah gave the book to Shaphan...

# The Josiah Revival



2 Ch 34:14-21 ...(19) Thus it happened, when the king heard the words of the Law, that he tore his clothes. (20) Then the king commanded Hilkiah, Ahikam the son of Shaphan, Abdon the son of Micah, Shaphan the scribe, and Asaiah a servant of the king, saying,...

# The Josiah Revival



2 Ch 34:22–25 So Hilkiah and those the king had appointed went to Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tokhath, the son of Hasrah, keeper of the wardrobe. (She dwelt in Jerusalem in the Second Quarter.) And they spoke to her to that effect. (23) Then she answered them, "Thus says the LORD God of Israel, 'Tell the man who sent you to Me,...

# The Josiah Revival



2 Ch 34:22–25 ... (24) "Thus says the LORD: 'Behold, I will bring calamity on this place and on its inhabitants, all the curses that are written in the book which they have read before the king of Judah, (25) because they have forsaken Me and burned incense to other gods, that they might provoke Me to anger with all the works of their hands. Therefore My wrath will be poured out on this place, and not be quenched.' " '

# The Josiah Revival

2 Ch 34:31–35:18 ...(35:1) Now Josiah kept a Passover to the LORD in Jerusalem, and they slaughtered the Passover lambs on the fourteenth day of the first month... ...(15) And the singers, the sons of Asaph, were in their places, according to the command of David, Asaph, Heman, and Jeduthun the king's seer. Also the gatekeepers were at each gate; they did not have to leave their position, because their brethren the Levites prepared portions for them...

# The Josiah Revival



2 Ch 34:31–35:18 ...(35:16) So all the service of the LORD was prepared the same day, to keep the Passover and to offer burnt offerings on the altar of the LORD, according to the command of King Josiah. (17) And the children of Israel who were present kept the Passover at that time, and the Feast of Unleavened Bread for seven days...

# The Josiah Revival



2 Ch 34:31–35:18 ... (35:18) There had been no Passover kept in Israel like that since the days of Samuel the prophet; and none of the kings of Israel had kept such a Passover as Josiah kept, with the priests and the Levites, all Judah and Israel who were present, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

(27) And the LORD said, "I will also remove Judah from My sight, as I have removed Israel, and will cast off this city Jerusalem which I have chosen, and the house of which I said, 'My name shall be there.' "

# The Josiah Revival

- Josiah exceeded David's righteousness
- Josiah's revival failed to stop judgment
- It did however preserve both the remnant of God's people and the manuscripts.
- Without Josiah's revival Ezra could not have restored the national life of Israel.

# Jesus Christ and the Pharisees



Hos 5:14–6:3 For I will be like a lion to Ephraim,  
And like a young lion to the house of Judah. I,  
even I, will tear them and go away; I will take  
them away, and no one shall rescue. (15) I will  
return again to My place Till they acknowledge  
their offense. Then they will seek My face; In their  
affliction they will earnestly seek Me."...

# Jesus Christ and the Pharisees



Hos 5:14–6:3 ... (6:1) Come, and let us return to the LORD; For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up. (2) After two days He will revive us; On the third day He will raise us up, That we may live in His sight. (3) Let us know, Let us pursue the knowledge of the LORD. His going forth is established as the morning; He will come to us like the rain, Like the latter and former rain to the earth.

# Jesus Christ and the Pharisees



- Israel suffered destruction rather than deliverance.
- Messianic Revival started the Church.
- After two days (2000 years) Israel to be revived.
- The Faltering Church to be revived with Israel.
- Final Great Awakening follows judgment
