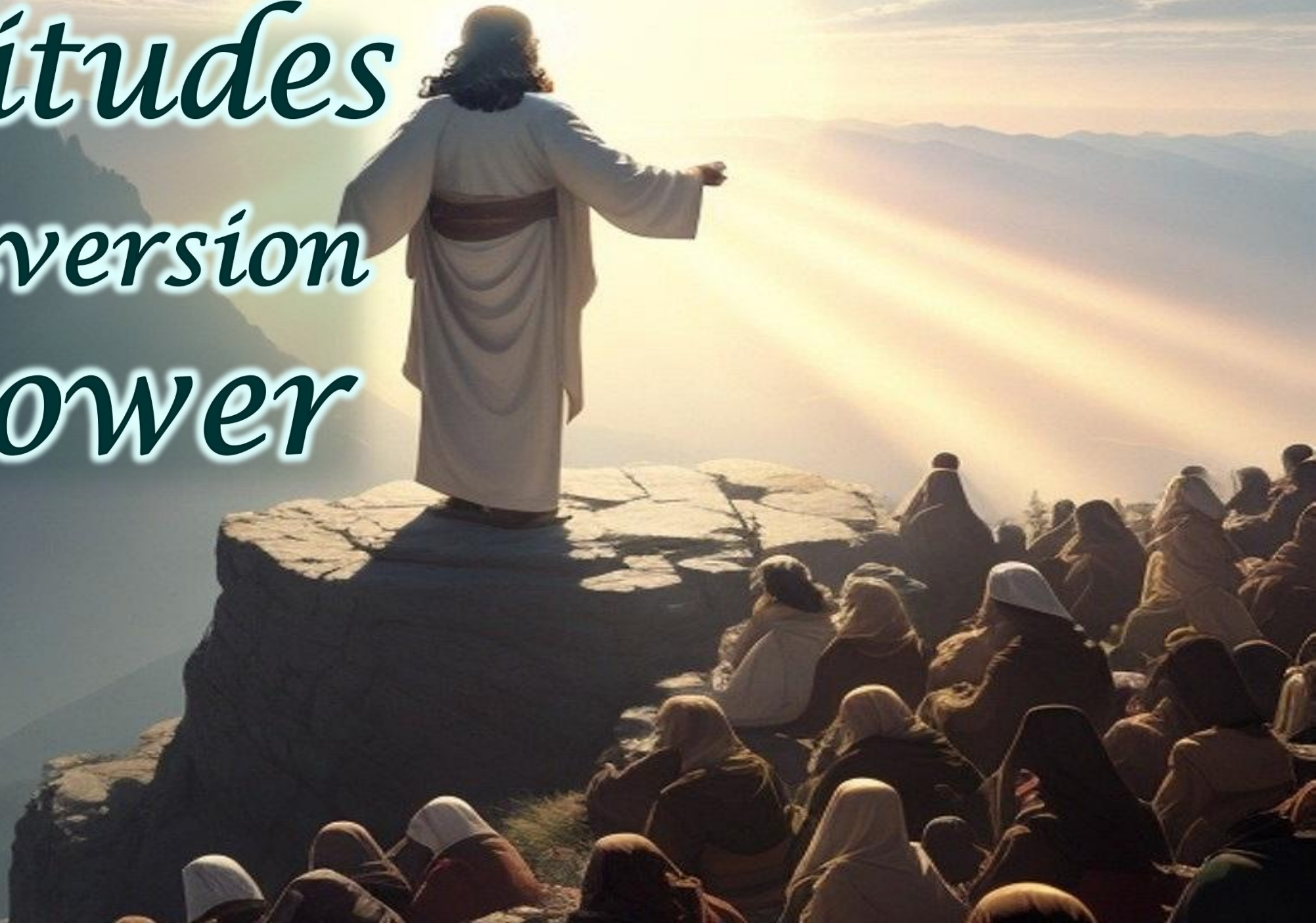


The Inversion

Light – God's Power to Completely Save

Mat 5:13–16 "...(14) "You are the light of the world. **A city that is set on a hill** cannot be hidden. (15) Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. (16) Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

The Light of the World is the Gospel

Rom 1:16–18 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for **it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes**, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. (17) For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "THE JUST SHALL LIVE BY FAITH. (18) For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven..."
