The Principles of God's Judgment

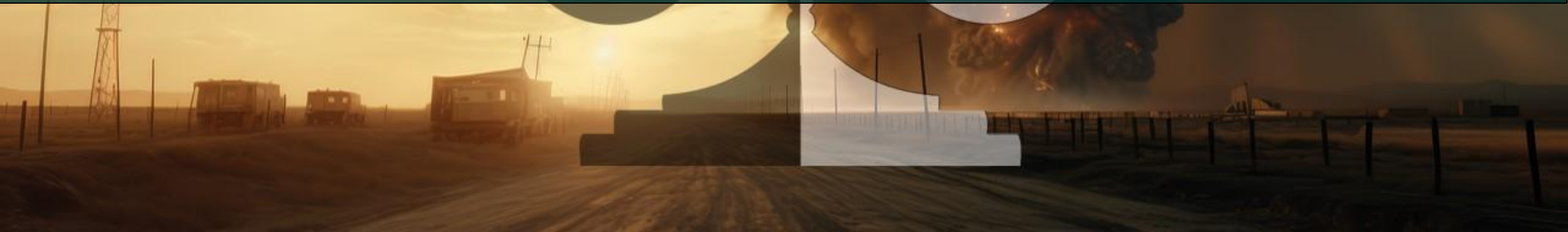
- God rewards nations according to their works.
- He measures back to the nations their deeds.
- He executes justice, particularly on bloodguilt.
- He waits until the cup of iniquity is full before He judges a nation.
- He uses other nations to execute judgment.

God Rewards Nations According to Their Works

- Unlike Individuals, Nations do not have eternal souls.
- Unlike Individuals, Nations cannot plead the blood of Jesus
- Unlike Individuals, Nations (except **true** Israel) cannot have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

God Rewards Nations According to Their Works

Jeremiah 25:14 KJV For many nations and great kings shall serve themselves of them also: and I will recompense them according to their deeds, and according to the works of their own hands.



God Rewards Nations According to Their Works

Hosea 12:2 KJV The LORD hath also a controversy with Judah, and will punish Jacob according to his ways; according to his doings will he recompense him.



God Rewards Nations According to Their Works

Romans 2:1–11 KJV ...(2) But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to truth against them which commit such things. (3) And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God?...

God Rewards Nations According to Their Works

Romans 2:1–11 KJV ... (5) But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God; (6) **Who will render to every man according to his deeds:**... ... (11) For there is no respect of persons with God.

He Measures Back to Nations Their Deeds

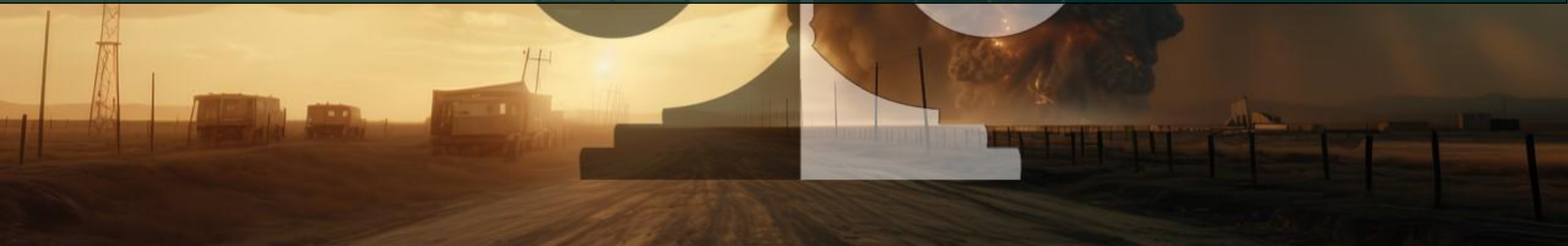
- His justice is precise, measuring back to the nations their injustices.
- Murderous nations suffer murder/genocide
- Sexually promiscuous/predatory nations suffer sexual predation
- Robber nations are robbed

He Measures Back to Nations Their Deeds

Matthew 7:1–3 KJV Judge not, that ye be not judged. (2) For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: **and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.** (3) And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

He Measures Back to Nations Their Deeds

Revelation 13:10 KJV He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.



He Measures Back to Nations Their Deeds

Jeremiah 50:29 KJV Call together the archers against Babylon: all ye that bend the bow, camp against it round about; let none thereof escape: **recompense her according to her work; according to all that she hath done, do unto her:** for she hath been proud against the LORD, against the Holy One of Israel.

He Measures Back to Nations Their Deeds

Ezekiel 7:2–3 KJV Also, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord GOD unto the land of Israel; An end, the end is come upon the four corners of the land. (3) Now is the end come upon thee, and I will send mine anger upon thee, **and will judge thee according to thy ways, and will recompense upon thee all thine abominations.**

He Executes Justice, Particularly on Bloodguilt

- Bloodguilt is the primary issue God uses to arbitrate wars involving powerful nations.
- There is a patterns of great wars being decided in favor of the least bloodguilty nation(s).
- The only way to cleanse the land of bloodguiltiness is justice against the murderers

He Executes Justice, Particularly on Bloodguilt

Genesis 9:4–6 KJV But flesh with the life thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall ye not eat. (5) And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man. (6) **Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man.**

He Executes Justice, Particularly on Bloodguilt

Numbers 35:31–34 KJV Moreover ye shall take no satisfaction for the life of a murderer, which is guilty of death: but he shall be surely put to death. (32) And ye shall take no satisfaction for him that is fled to the city of his refuge, that he should come again to dwell in the land, until the death of the priest...

He Executes Justice, Particularly on Bloodguilt

Numbers 35:31–34 KJV ... (33) So ye shall not pollute the land wherein ye are: for blood it defileth the land: and the land cannot be cleansed of the blood that is shed therein, but by the blood of him that shed it. (34) Defile not therefore the land which ye shall inhabit, wherein I dwell: for I the LORD dwell among the children of Israel.

He Waits Until The Cup of Iniquity is Full

- He waits until a nation is filled with sin.
- A righteous remnant can stay judgment.

He Waits Until The Cup of Iniquity is Full

Genesis 15:13–16 KJV And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them four hundred years; (14) And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance...

He Waits Until The Cup of Iniquity is Full

Ezekiel 9:9 KJV Then said he unto me, The iniquity of the house of Israel and Judah is exceeding great, and the land is full of blood, and the city full of perverseness: for they say, The LORD hath forsaken the earth, and the LORD seeth not.

He Waits Until The Cup of Iniquity is Full

Revelation 18:2–5 KJV And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen..., ...(4) And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues. (5) **For her sins have reached unto heaven, and God hath remembered her iniquities.**
