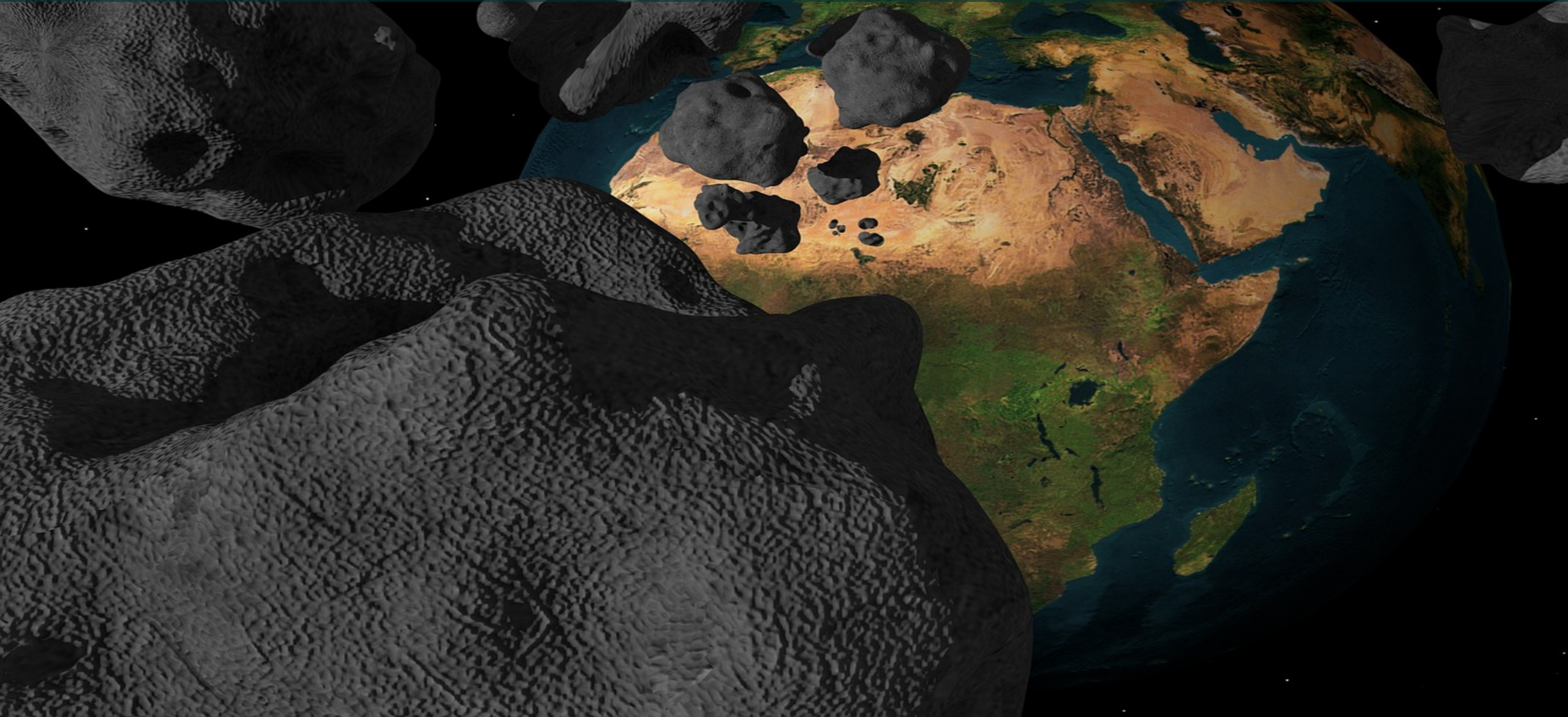

# Judgment on Israel's Enemies

Zec 9:1–8 The burden of the word of the LORD—Against the land of Hadrach, And Damascus its resting place (For the eyes of men And all the tribes of Israel Are on the LORD); (2) Also against Hamath, which borders on it, And against Tyre and Sidon, though they are very wise. (3) For Tyre built herself a tower, Heaped up silver like the dust, And gold like the mire of the streets...





# Judgment on Israel's Enemies

Zec 9:1–8 ...(4) Behold, the LORD will cast her out; He will destroy her power in the sea, And she will be devoured by fire. (5) Ashkelon shall see it and fear; Gaza also shall be very sorrowful; And Ekron, for He dried up her expectation. The king shall perish from Gaza, And Ashkelon shall not be inhabited...





# Judgment on Israel's Enemies

Zec 9:1–8 ...(6) "A mixed race shall settle in Ashdod, And I will cut off the pride of the Philistines. (7) I will take away the blood from his mouth, And the abominations from between his teeth. But he who remains, even he shall be for our God, And shall be like a leader in Judah, And Ekron like a Jebusite...





# Judgment on Israel's Enemies

Zec 9:1–8 ...(8) I will camp around My house Because of the army, Because of him who passes by and him who returns. No more shall an oppressor pass through them, For now I have seen with My eyes.





# *The Coming of the King of Zion*

Zec 9:9 "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey..."





# *The Triumphal Entry of the King of Zion*

Mat 21:1–6 Now when they drew near Jerusalem, and came to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, (2) saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Loose them and bring them to Me...

Mat 21:1–6 ...(3) And if anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord has need of them,' and immediately he will send them." (4) All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying:...





# *The Triumphal Entry of the King of Zion*

Mat 21:1–6 ...(5) "TELL THE DAUGHTER OF ZION, 'BEHOLD, YOUR KING IS COMING TO YOU, LOWLY, AND SITTING ON A DONKEY, A COLT, THE FOAL OF A DONKEY.'" (6) So the disciples went and did as Jesus commanded them.

# *The Diaspora of Israel*

Matthew 23:37–39 NKJV "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing! (38) See! Your house is left to you desolate; (39) for I say to you, you shall see Me no more till you say, 'BLESSED is HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!' "





# *The End of the Diaspora of Israel*

Psalms 118:10-12 NKJV All nations surrounded me, But in the name of the LORD I will destroy them. (11) They surrounded me, Yes, they surrounded me; But in the name of the LORD I will destroy them. (12) They surrounded me like bees; They were quenched like a fire of thorns; For in the name of the LORD I will destroy them.





# *Repentance Brings Revival and Deliverance*

Psalms 118:22-26 NKJV The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone. (23) This was the LORD's doing; It is marvelous in our eyes. (24) This is the day the LORD has made; We will rejoice and be glad in it. (25) Save now, I pray, O LORD; O LORD, I pray, send now prosperity. (26) Blessed is he who comes in the name of the LORD! We have blessed you from the house of the LORD.





# *Repentance Brings Revival and Deliverance*

Romans 11:11-15 NKJV I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation has come to the Gentiles. (12) Now if their fall is riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness! (13) For I speak to you Gentiles; inasmuch as I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry,...

Romans 11:11–15 NKJV ...(14) if by any means I may provoke to jealousy those who are my flesh and save some of them. (15) For if their being cast away is the reconciling of the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead?

Zec 9:10-13 "... (12) Return to the stronghold, You prisoners of hope. Even today I declare That I will restore double to you. (13) For I have bent Judah, My bow, Fitted the bow with Ephraim, And raised up your sons, O Zion, Against your sons, O Greece, And made you like the sword of a mighty man."





# *The Deliverance of Israel*

Zec 9:14–17 Then the LORD will be seen over them, And His arrow will go forth like lightning. The Lord GOD will blow the trumpet, And go with whirlwinds from the south. (15) The LORD of hosts will defend them; They shall devour and subdue with slingstones. They shall drink and roar as if with wine; They shall be filled with blood like basins, Like the corners of the altar...





# *The Deliverance of Israel*

Zec 9:14–17 ...(16) The LORD their God will save them in that day, As the flock of His people. For they shall be like the jewels of a crown, Lifted like a banner over His land—  
(17) For how great is its goodness And how great its beauty! Grain shall make the young men thrive, And new wine the young women.
