Supremacy of Christ

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, (2) Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;...



Supremacy of Christ

John 1:1–3 KJV In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (2) The same was in the beginning with God. (3) All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.



Supremacy of Christ

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ... (3) Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high; (4) Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they...



Supremacy of Christ

Colossians 1:13–16 KJV Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:… ..(15) Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: (16) For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:



Supremacy of Christ

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ... (5) For unto which of the angels said he at any time, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee? And again, I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son? (6) And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him...



Supremacy of Christ

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ..(10) And, Thou, Lord, in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thine hands: (11) They shall perish; but thou remainest; and they all shall wax old as doth a garment; (12) And as a vesture shalt thou fold them up, and they shall be changed: but thou art the same, and thy years shall not fail...



Supremacy of Christ

Psalms 102:25-27 KJV Of old hast thou laid the foundation of the earth: and the heavens are the work of thy hands. (26) They shall perish, but thou shalt endure: yea, all of them shall wax old like a garment; as a vesture shalt thou change them, and they shall be changed: (27) But thou art the same, and thy years shall have no end.



Supremacy of Christ

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ... (7) And of the angels he saith, Who maketh his angels spirits, and his ministers a flame of fire. (8) But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom. (9) Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows...



Supremacy of Christ, the God-Man

Psalms 45:6-7 KJV Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre. (7) Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness: therefore God, thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.



Supremacy of Christ

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ... (13) But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? (14) Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?...



Do Not Neglect Christ's Salvation

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ...(2:1) Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things, which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them slip. (2:2) For if the word spoken by angels was stedfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompence of reward;...



Do Not Neglect Christ's Salvation

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ...(2:3) How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him; (4) God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will? (5) For unto the angels hath he not put in subjection the world to come, whereof we speak...



Christ Also Glorified as Man

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ... (2:6) But one in a certain place testified, saying, What is man, that thou art mindful of him? or the son of man, that thou visitest him? (7) Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with glory and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands:...



Christ Also Glorified as Man

Psalms 8:3–6 KJV When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained; (4) What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?...



Christ Also Glorified as Man

Psalms 8:3–6 KJV ... (5) For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour. (6) Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet:



Christ Also Glorified as Man

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ...(2:8) Thou hast put all things in subjection under his feet. For in that he put all in subjection under him, he left nothing that is not put under him. But now we see not yet all things put under him. (9) But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man...



Christ Also Glorified as Man

1 Corinthians 15:25–28 KJV For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. (26) The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. (27) For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him...



Christ Also Glorified as Man

1 Corinthians 15:25–28 KJV ...(28)
And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.



Christ Became Like Us to Make Communion with God Possible

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ...(2:10) For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. (11) For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,...



Christ Became Like Us to Make Communion with God Possible

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ...(2:12) Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee. (13) And again, I will put my trust in him. And again, Behold I and the children which God hath given me...



Christ Became Like Us to Make Communion with God Possible

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ... (2:14) Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; (15) And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage....



Christ Became Like Us to Make Communion with God Possible

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ...(2:16) For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham. (17) Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people. (18) For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted..



Moses Faithful as a Servant in God's House, Christ Faithful as a Son in God's House

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ... (3:1) Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus; (2) Who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house. (3) For this man was counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as he who hath builded the house hath more honour than the house...



Moses Faithful as a Servant in God's House, Christ Faithful as a Son in God's House

Hebrews 1:1–3:6 KJV ...(3:4) For every house is builded by some man; but he that built all things is God. (5) And Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after; (6) But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end.



Moses Faithful as a Servant in God's House, Christ Faithful as a Son in God's House

Numbers 12:4–8 KJV And the LORD spake suddenly unto Moses, and unto Aaron, and unto Miriam, Come out ye three unto the tabernacle of the congregation. And they three came out. (5) And the LORD came down in the pillar of the cloud, and stood in the door of the tabernacle, and called Aaron and Miriam: and they both came forth....



Moses Faithful as a Servant in God's House, Christ Faithful as a Son in God's House

Numbers 12:4-8 KJV ...**(6)** And he said, Hear now my words: If there be a prophet among you, I the LORD will make myself known unto him in a vision, and will speak unto him in a dream. **(7) My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all mine house...**

Numbers 12:4-8 KJV ... (8) With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently, and not in dark speeches; and the similitude of the LORD shall he behold: wherefore then were ye not afraid to speak against my servant Moses?
