The Immutability of God's Promises, an Anchor for the Soul

Hebrews 6:13-7:28 KJV For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself, (14) Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee. (15) And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise...



The Immutability of God's Promises, an Anchor for the Soul

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ... (16) For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife. (17) Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath:...

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV...(18) That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:....



The Immutability of God's Promises, an Anchor for the Soul

John 14:6 KJV Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

1 John 2:21 KJV I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but because ye know it, and that no lie is of the truth.



The Immutability of God's Promises, an Anchor for the Soul

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ... (19) Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil; (20) Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec...



The Priesthood of Melchizedek

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ...(7:1) For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him; (2) To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace;...



The Priesthood of Melchizedek

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ... (7:3)
Without father, without mother,
without descent, having neither
beginning of days, nor end of life;
but made like unto the Son of God;
abideth a priest continually...



The Superiority of the Priesthood of Melchizedek

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ... (7:4) Now consider how great this man was, unto whom even the patriarch Abraham gave the tenth of the spoils. (5) And verily they that are of the sons of Levi, who receive the office of the priesthood, have a commandment to take tithes of the people according to the law, that is, of their brethren, though they come out of the loins of Abraham:...



The Superiority of the Priesthood of Melchizedek

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ... (7:6) But he whose descent is not counted from them received tithes of Abraham, and blessed him that had the promises. (7) And without all contradiction the less is blessed of the better...



The Superiority of the Priesthood of Melchizedek

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV...(7:8) And here men that die receive tithes; but there he receiveth them, of whom it is witnessed that he liveth. (9) And as I may so say, Levi also, who receiveth tithes, payed tithes in Abraham. (10) For he was yet in the loins of his father, when Melchisedec met him....




The Superiority of the Priesthood of Melchizedek

Genesis 14:17-20 KJV And the king of Sodom went out to meet him after his return from the slaughter of Chedorlaomer, and of the kings that were with him, at the valley of Shaveh, which is the king's dale...



The Superiority of the Priesthood of Melchizedek

Genesis 14:17-20 KJV ... (18)
And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.



The Superiority of the Priesthood of Melchizedek

Genesis 14:17-20 KJV...(19) And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth: (20) And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.



The Necessity of the New Covenant

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ... (7:11) If therefore perfection were by the Levitical priesthood, (for under it the people received the law,) what further need was there that another priest should rise after the order of Melchisedec, and not be called after the order of Aaron?..



The Necessity of the New Covenant

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ...(7:12) For the priesthood being changed, there is made of necessity a change also of the law. (13) For he of whom these things are spoken pertaineth to another tribe, of which no man gave attendance at the altar. (14) For it is evident that our Lord sprang out of Juda; of which tribe Moses spake nothing concerning priesthood....



The Necessity of the New Covenant

Matthew 26:26–28 KJV And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body. (27) And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it; (28) For this is my blood of the **new testament**, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

The Weakness of the Mosaic Covenant

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ...(7:15) And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth another priest, (16) Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life. (17) For he testifieth, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec...



The Weakness of the Mosaic Covenant

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ... (7:18) For there is verily a disannulling of the commandment going before for the weakness and unprofitableness thereof. (19) For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better hope did; by the which we draw nigh unto God. (20) And inasmuch as not without an oath he was made priest:...



Jesus - the High Priest of Promise

Hebrews 6:13–7:28 KJV ...(7:21) (For those priests were made without an oath; but this with an oath by him that said unto him, The Lord sware and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec:) (22) By so much was Jesus made a surety of a better testament...



Jesus - the High Priest of Promise

Hebrews 6:13-7:28 KJV ... (7:23) And they truly were many priests, because they were not suffered to continue by reason of death: (24) But this man, because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood. (25) Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them....



Jesus - the High Priest of Promise

Hebrews 6:13-7:28 KJV ... (7:26) For such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens; (27) Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself...



Jesus - the High Priest of Promise

Hebrews 6:13-7:28 KJV ... (7:28)
For the law maketh men high priests which have infirmity; but the word of the oath, which was since the law, maketh the Son, who is consecrated for evermore.



Jesus - the High Priest of Promise

Romans 4:13-16 KJV For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith. (14) For if they which are of the law be heirs, faith is made void, and the promise made of none effect:...



Jesus - the High Priest of Promise

Romans 4:13-16 KJV ... (15) Because the law worketh wrath: for where no law is, there is no transgression. (16) Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,
