# Christ High Priest in Heavenly Temple

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens; (2) A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man...



# Christ High Priest in Heavenly Temple

Revelation 15:1–6 KJV And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God. (2) And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God....



# Christ High Priest in Heavenly Temple

Revelation 15:1–6 KJV ... (3) And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints. (4) Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest...



# Christ High Priest in Heavenly Temple

Revelation 15:1–6 KJV ... (5) And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened: (6) And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles.



# Christ High Priest in Heavenly Temple

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ... (3) For every high priest is ordained to offer gifts and sacrifices: wherefore it is of necessity that this man have somewhat also to offer...



# Earthly Temple a Shadow

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ... (4) For if he were on earth, he should not be a priest, seeing that there are priests that offer gifts according to the law: (5) Who serve unto the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, that thou make all things according to the pattern shewed to thee in the mount...



# Earthly Temple a Shadow

Colossians 2:16–17 KJV Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: (17) which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ.



# *The New Covenant Supersedes the Mosaic Covenant*

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ... (6) But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. (7) For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second...



# *The New Covenant Supersedes the Mosaic Covenant*

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ... (8) For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: (9) Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord..



# *The New Covenant Supersedes the Mosaic Covenant*

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ... (10) For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:...



# *The New Covenant Supersedes the Mosaic Covenant*

Hebrews, 8:1–9:10 KJV ...(11) And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest. (12) For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more....



# *The New Covenant Supersedes the Mosaic Covenant*

Jeremiah 31:31–34 KJV Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah: (32) Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD:...



# *The New Covenant Supersedes the Mosaic Covenant*

Jeremiah 31:31–34 KJV ...(33) But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people...



# *The New Covenant Supersedes the Mosaic Covenant*

Jeremiah 31:31–34 KJV ...(34) And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.



# *The New Covenant Supersedes the Mosaic Covenant*

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ... (13)  
In that he saith, A new covenant,  
he hath made the first old. Now  
that which decayeth and waxeth  
old is ready to vanish away.



# The Vanishing Away of the Mosaic Covenant

- The Jerusalem Council Only Liberated Gentiles from the Mosaic Covenant (Acts 15; 21:20–26)
- The Mosaic Covenant Provides for removal from the land as a declaration of breach (Deut 28:15–68, esp 63–64)



# *First Hebrews Christians Observed the Mosaic Covenant*

Acts 21:20–26 KJV And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe; and they are all zealous of the law: (21) And they are informed of thee, that thou teachest all the Jews which are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, saying that they ought not to circumcise their children, neither to walk after the customs...



# *First Hebrews Christians Observed the Mosaic Covenant*

Acts 21:20–26 KJV ...(22) What is it therefore? the multitude must needs come together: for they will hear that thou art come. (23) Do therefore this that we say to thee: We have four men which have a vow on them;..



# *First Hebrews Christians Observed the Mosaic Covenant*

Acts 21:20–26 KJV ... (24) They take, and purify thyself with them, and be at charges with them, that they may shave their heads: and all may know that those things, whereof they were informed concerning thee, are nothing; but that thou thyself also walkest orderly, and keepest the law....



# *First Hebrews Christians Observed the Mosaic Covenant*

Acts 21:20–26 KJV ...(25) As touching the Gentiles which believe, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from things offered to idols, and from blood, and from strangled, and from fornication...



# *First Hebrews Christians Observed the Mosaic Covenant*

Acts 21:20–26 KJV ...(26) Then Paul took the men, and the next day purifying himself with them entered into the temple, to signify the accomplishment of the days of purification, until that an offering should be offered for every one of them.



# The Breach of the Mosaic Covenant

Deuteronomy 28:63–64 KJV And it shall come to pass, that as the LORD rejoiced over you to do you good, and to multiply you; so the LORD will rejoice over you to destroy you, and to bring you to nought; and ye shall be plucked from off the land whither thou goest to possess it....




# The Breach of the Mosaic Covenant

Deuteronomy 28:63–64 KJV ...(64) And the LORD shall scatter thee among all people, from the one end of the earth even unto the other; and there thou shalt serve other gods, which neither thou nor thy fathers have known, even wood and stone.

# *The Mosaic Covenant Could Never Take Away Sins*

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ...(9:1) Then verily the first covenant had also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary. (2) For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein was the candlestick, and the table, and the shewbread; which is called the sanctuary....



# *The Mosaic Covenant Could Never Take Away Sins*

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ... (9:3) And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all; (4) Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant;...



# *The Mosaic Covenant Could Never Take Away Sins*

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ...(9:5) And over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercyseat; of which we cannot now speak particularly. (6) Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of God...



# *The Mosaic Covenant Could Never Take Away Sins*

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ...(9:7) But into the second, went the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people: (8) The Holy Ghost this signifying, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing:...



# *The Mosaic Covenant Could Never Take Away Sins*

Hebrews 8:1–9:10 KJV ... (9:9) Which was a figure for the time then present, in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience; (10) Which stood only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed on them until the time of reformation.



# *The Mosaic Covenant Could Never Take Away Sins*

Galatians 3:22–25 KJV But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe. (23) But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed...



# *The Mosaic Covenant Could Never Take Away Sins*

Galatians 3:22–25 KJV ... (24)  
Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. (25) But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.
