The Greatness of the Mosaic Covenant

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV For ye are not come unto the mount that might be touched, and that burned with fire, nor unto blackness, and darkness, and tempest, (19) And the sound of a trumpet, and the voice of words; which voice they that heard intreated that the word should not be spoken to them any more:....

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ... (20) (For they could not endure that which was commanded, And if so much as a beast touch the mountain, it shall be stoned, or thrust through with a dart: (21) And so terrible was the sight, that Moses said, I exceedingly fear and quake...

The Superior Greatness of the New Covenant

2 Corinthians 3:7-18 KJV But if the ministration of death, written and engraven in stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the glory of his countenance; which glory was to be done away: (8) How shall not the ministration of the spirit be rather glorious?...

2 Corinthians 3:7-18 KJV ...(9) For if the ministration of condemnation be glory, much more doth the ministration of righteousness exceed in glory. (10) For even that which was made glorious had no glory in this respect, by reason of the glory that excelleth. (11) For if that which is done away was glorious, much more that which remaineth is glorious...

2 Corinthians 3:7-18 KJV ...(12) Seeing then that we have such hope, we use great plainness of speech: (13) And not as Moses, which put a vail over his face, that the children of Israel could not stedfastly look to the end of that which is abolished:...

2 Corinthians 3:7-18 KJV ...(14) But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which vail is done away in Christ. (15) But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart. (16) Nevertheless when it shall turn to the Lord, the vail shall be taken away...

The Superior Greatness of the New Covenant

2 Corinthians 3:7-18 KJV ...(17) Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. (18) But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ...(24) And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel. (25) See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from him that speaketh from heaven:...

The Unshakeable Kingdom

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ...(26) Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven... (27) And this word, Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain...

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ... (28)
Wherefore we receiving a kingdom
which cannot be moved, let us have
grace, whereby we may serve God
acceptably with reverence and godly
fear: (29) For our God is a consuming
fire....

Admonitions for Conduct in Light of the Unshakeable Kingdom

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ...(13:1) Let brotherly love continue. (2) Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares. (3) Remember them that are in bonds, as bound with them; and them which suffer adversity, as being yourselves also in the body....



THE UNSHAKABLE KINGDOM

Admonitions for Conduct in Light of the Unshakeable Kingdom

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ... (13:4)
Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge. (5) Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee....

Admonitions for Conduct in Light of the Unshakeable Kingdom

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ...(13:6) So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me. (7) Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation...



THE UNSHAKABLE KINGDOM

Admonitions for Conduct in Light of the Unshakeable Kingdom

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ...(13:8) Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. (9) Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein...



THE UNSHAKABLE KINGDOM

Admonitions for Conduct in Light of the Unshakeable Kingdom

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ...(13:10) We have an altar, whereof they have no right to eat which serve the tabernacle. (11) For the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp...



THE UNSHAKABLE KINGDOM

Admonitions for Conduct in Light of the Unshakeable Kingdom

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ...(13:12)
Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate. (13) Let us go forth therefore unto him without the camp, bearing his reproach. (14) For here have we no continuing city, but we seek one to come....



THE UNSHAKABLE KINGDOM

Admonitions for Conduct in Light of the Unshakeable Kingdom

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV...(13:15) By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. (16) But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased....

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ...(13:17)
Obey them that have the rule over you,
and submit yourselves: for they watch
for your souls, as they that must give
account, that they may do it with joy,
and not with grief: for that is
unprofitable for you....

Hebrews 12:18–13:25 KJV ... (13:18)
Pray for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly. (19) But I beseech you the rather to do this, that I may be restored to you the sooner....
