Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, (20) By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; (21) And having an high priest over the house of God;...



Entering God's Courts by Faith

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ...(22) Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. (23) Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)...

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (24) And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: (25) Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching..

Mark 8:16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (26) For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, (27) But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries...

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (28) He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: (29) Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?...

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (30)
For we know him that hath said,
Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (32) But call to remembrance the former days, in which, after ye were illuminated, ye endured a great fight of afflictions; (33) Partly, whilst ye were made a gazingstock both by reproaches and afflictions; and partly, whilst ye became companions of them that were so used....

Mark 8:16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ...(34)
For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance...

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (35) Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. (36) For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. (37) For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry...



The Just Shall Live by Faith

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (38)
Now the just shall live by faith:
but if any man draw back, my soul shall
have no pleasure in him. (39) But we
are not of them who draw back unto
perdition; but of them that believe to
the saving of the soul..



Faith Mindful of the Eternal Decree of God

Habakkuk 2:3-4 KJV For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry. (4) Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.



The Progressive Unfolding of Faith

Mark 16

Romans 1:16–17 KJV For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. (17) For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, **The just shall live by faith.**



Faith as the Foundation of One's Life

Galatians 3:10–11 KJV For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them. (11) But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, **The just shall live by faith.**

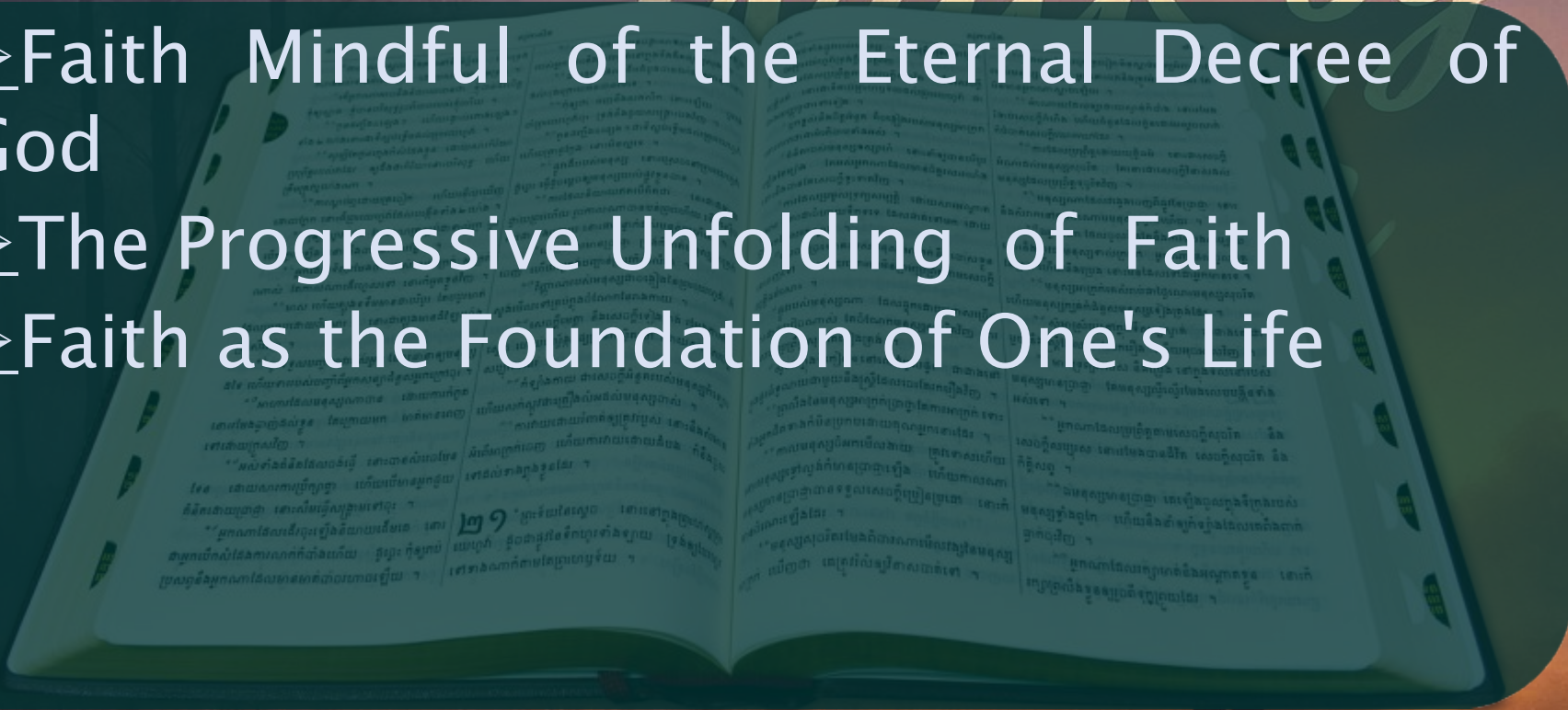

The Mechanics of Faith

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (11:1) Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. (2) For by it the elders obtained a good report. (3) Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear....



The Mechanics of Faith

- Faith is evidence of the invisible world (elegchos | ἔλεγχος | G1650)
- Faith substantiates hope (hupostasis | hupostasis | G5287)
- Faith allows us deeper access to the invisible world (φαίνω | phainō | G5316)



Substantiate, as Confidence or Essence

Mark 16

- hupostasis | G5287 can be translated confidence or essence
- If confidence is meant here, then faith is a more passive construct limited to trusting God – phaino revelation of truth
- If essence or substance is meant here, then faith is an instrument that alters the real world – phaino revelation of reality



Why Substance is a Better Translation

Mark 16

- phaino is presented in verse 3 as a revelation of reality “things which are seen were not made of things which do appear”
- If the substance of created visible things does not come into view upon observation, then what is happening?



Why Substance is a Better Translation

Walk by

➤ The substance of created visible things is constructed upon observation, from the Rhema Word of God

(3) Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word (Rhema) of God,



Why Substance is a Better Translation

What do you

➤ Rhema is particular word of God, It is ontologically distinct from God, unlike the Logos (full counsel of God – Personified in the Son John 1:1)



Why Substance is a Better Translation

Mark 16:7

- Rhema provides the information used to construct physical reality at the point it comes into view.
- This has an intersection with quantum mechanics, in which the Standard Model asserts that material reality emerges when an observation collapses the wave-function



Faith Influences Parsing the Wave-function

Mark 16

➤ As man observes God's world, he parses information the rhema word put into the wave-function, constructing the objects of our experience

Hebrews 11:3 KJV Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

➤ Romans 10:17 KJV So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

➤ The Rhema word transforms senses.

➤ The transformed senses produce faith (Romans 10:17)

➤ Faith produces confession (Luke 6:45)



The Mechanics of Faith

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (11:4)
By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh....



The Mechanics of Faith

MARK 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ...(11:5)
By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God....



The Mechanics of Active Faith

Mark 16

- BY FAITH – πιστει – Pistei – G4102
- Dative Noun – instrumentation (in, through, by, etc)
- Shows faith as an active agent
- “By faith” Found 16 times in the narrative of Hebrews 11, “through faith” six times



The Word of Faith vs the "Word of Faith!!!"

MARK 6

- Biblical Word of Faith is tethered to the word of God, and His promises
- The WOF/NAR movements disconnect faith from the word of God, making it an idol



Necessary Motivation to Exercise Faith

Mark 11:23

- Believe That He is Who He Says He is, and;
- That He Will Reward you if You Seek Him Diligently

Mark 11:24

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (11:6) But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. (7) By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear,...



Believe That He is Who He Says He is, and That He Will Reward you if You Seek Him

Mark 10

Hebrews 10:19-11:40 KJV ... (11:7)...
prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by
the which he condemned the world, and
became heir of the righteousness which is by
faith. (8) By faith Abraham, when he was
called to go out into a place which he should
after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and
he went out, not knowing whither he went....

Mark 11:19

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (11:9) By
faith he sojourned in the land of promise,
as in a strange country, dwelling in
tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs
with him of the same promise: (10) For he
looked for a city which hath foundations,
whose builder and maker is God....

Mark 10

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ...(11:11)
Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised. (12) Therefore sprang there even of one, and him as good as dead,...

Mark 10

Hebrews 10:19-11:40 KJV ... (11:12)... so many as the stars of the sky in multitude, and as the sand which is by the sea shore innumerable. (13) These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth....

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ...(11:14)
For they that say such things declare
plainly that they seek a country. (15)
And truly, if they had been mindful of

Mark 10

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (11:21) By faith Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and worshipped, leaning upon the top of his staff. (22) By faith Joseph, when he died, made mention of the departing of the children of Israel; and gave commandment concerning his bones...



Believe That He is Who He Says He is, and That He Will Reward you if You Seek Him

Mark 10

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (11:23) By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment. (24) By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;..

Mark 10

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (11:25)
Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the
people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures
of sin for a season; (26) Esteeming the
reproach of Christ greater riches than the
treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto
the recompence of the reward...



Believe That He is Who He Says He is, and That He Will Reward you if You Seek Him

Mark 10

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (11:27) By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible. (28) Through faith he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them...



Believe That He is Who He Says He is, and That He Will Reward you if You Seek Him

Mark 11:24

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (11:29) By faith they passed through the Red sea as by dry land: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned. (30) By faith the walls of Jericho fell down, after they were compassed about seven days. (31) By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace...



Enduring and Overcoming Faith

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (11:32) And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, and of the prophets: (33) Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,..

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ...(11:34)
Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge
of the sword, out of weakness were made
strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight
the armies of the aliens. (35) Women received
their dead raised to life again: and others were
tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they
might obtain a better resurrection:...



Enduring and Overcoming Faith

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (36) And others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment: (37) They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented;...



Enduring and Overcoming Faith

Mark 16

Hebrews 10:19–11:40 KJV ... (38) (Of whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered in deserts, and in mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth. (39) And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise: (40) God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.
