Passover in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:1-14 KJV And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, (2) This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you...

Passover in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:1-14 KJV ... (3) Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:...

Passover in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:1–14 KJV ... (4) And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbour next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb...

Passover in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:1–14 KJV ... (5) Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats: (6) And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening...

Passover in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:1–14 KJV ... (7) And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it. (8) And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; and with bitter herbs they shall eat it...

Passover in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:1–14 KJV ... (9) Eat not of it raw, nor sodden at all with water, but roast with fire; his head with his legs, and with the purtenance thereof. (10) And ye shall let nothing of it remain until the morning; and that which remaineth of it until the morning ye shall burn with fire....

Passover in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:1–14 KJV ... (11) And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the LORD'S passover. (12) For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD...

Passover in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:1–14 KJV ...(13) And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt...

Passover in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:1-14 KJV ...(14) And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a feast to the LORD throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever.

Passover the First of the Seven Feasts

Leviticus 23:1-2, 4-5 KJV And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, (2) Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts...

Passover the First of the Seven Feasts

Leviticus 23:1-2, 4-5 KJV ... (4)
These are the feasts of the LORD,
even holy convocations, which ye
shall proclaim in their seasons. (5) In
the fourteenth day of the first month
at even is the LORD'S passover.



DALLAS I CARTER

Passover Fulfilled in the New Covenant

Matthew 26:17-29 KJV Now the first day of the feast of unleavened bread the disciples came to Jesus, saying unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare for thee to eat the passover? (18) And he said, Go into the city to such a man, and say unto him, The Master saith, My time is at hand; I will keep the passover at thy house with my disciples....

Passover Fulfilled in the New Covenant

Matthew 26:17–29 KJV ... (26) And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body. (27) And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it;..

Passover Fulfilled in the New Covenant

Matthew 26:17–29 KJV ...(28) For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. (29) But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.

The Significance of the Passover

SEVEN FEASTS

- In the Mosaic Covenant, it provided Protection from the death Angel in Egypt
- In the New Covenant, it provides Protection from the wrath of God against all sin
- Blood covering is a hard requirement

SEVEN FEASTS

1 Corinthians 5:7 KJV Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

Genesis 15:6 KJV And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.

SEVEN FEASTS

Romans 4:2-3 KJV For if Abraham were justified by works, he hath whereof to glory; but not before God. (3) For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.
