The Feast of Pentecost or Weeks in the Mosaic Covenant.

Leviticus 23:15–22 NKJV 'And you shall count for yourselves from the day after the Sabbath, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering: seven Sabbaths shall be completed. (16) Count fifty days to the day after the seventh Sabbath; then you shall offer a new grain offering to the LORD...

The Feast of Pentecost or Weeks in the Mosaic Covenant.

Leviticus 23:15-22 NKJV '...(17)
You shall bring from your dwellings two wave loaves of two-tenths of an ephah. They shall be of fine flour; they shall be baked with leaven. They are the firstfruits to the LORD...

The Feast of Pentecost or Weeks in the Mosaic Covenant.

Leviticus 23:15–22 NKJV '...(18) And you shall offer with the bread seven lambs of the first year, without blemish, one young bull, and two rams. They shall be as a burnt offering to the LORD, with their grain offering and their drink offerings, an offering made by fire for a sweet aroma to the LORD...

The Feast of Pentecost or Weeks in the Mosaic Covenant.

Leviticus 23:15–22 NKJV '...(19) Then you shall sacrifice one kid of the goats as a sin offering, and two male lambs of the first year as a sacrifice of a peace offering. (20) The priest shall wave them with the bread of the firstfruits as a wave offering before the LORD, with the two lambs. They shall be holy to the LORD for the priest...

The Feast of Pentecost or Weeks in the Mosaic Covenant.

Leviticus 23:15–22 NKJV (21)
And you shall proclaim on the same day that it is a holy convocation to you. You shall do no customary work on it. It shall be a statute forever in all your dwellings throughout your generations.

The Feast of Pentecost or Weeks in the Mosaic Covenant.

Leviticus 23:15-22 NKJV '...(22) When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not wholly reap the corners of your field when you reap, nor shall you gather any gleaning from your harvest. You shall leave them for the poor and for the stranger: I am the LORD your God.' "

SEVEN FEASTS

Acts 2:1–4 NKJV When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. (2) And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting...

SEVEN FEASTS

Acts 2:1–4 NKJV ... (3) Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. (4) And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

The Significance of the Feast of Pentecost/Weeks

SEVEN FEASTS

- The Feast of Pentecost began the harvest of souls into the Church
- The Holy Spirit was poured out to give people power to become Children of God that were to be harvested
- These Children are Harvested at the End of the Age

The Feast of Pentecost Began the Harvest of Souls into the Church

Acts 2:41 NKJV Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.

John 3:3 NKJV Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

SEVEN FEASTS

1 Peter 1:23 NKJV having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever,

SEVENTH FEASTS

Matthew 13:37-43 NKJV He answered and said to them: "He who sows the good seed is the Son of Man. (38) The field is the world, the good seeds are the sons of the kingdom, but the tares are the sons of the wicked one. (39) The enemy who sowed them is the devil, the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels..."



DALLAS I CARTER

These Children are Harvested at the End of the Age

SEVENTH FEASTS

Matthew 13:37-43 NKJV ...(40) Therefore as the tares are gathered and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of this age. (41) The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and those who practice lawlessness,...

These Children are Harvested at the End of the Age

SEVENTH FEASTS

Matthew 13:37–43 NKJV ...(42) and will cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth. (43) Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears to hear, let him hear!

Revelation 14:14–16 NKJV Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and on the cloud sat One like the Son of Man, having on His head a golden crown, and in His hand a sharp sickle...

SEVEN FEASTS

Revelation 14:14-16 NKJV ...(15) And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, "Thrust in Your sickle and reap, for the time has come for You to reap, for the harvest of the earth is ripe." (16) So He who sat on the cloud thrust in His sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped.
