The Feast of Unleavened Bread in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:16–19 KJV And in the first day there shall be an holy convocation, and in the seventh day there shall be an holy convocation to you; no manner of work shall be done in them, save that which every man must eat, that only may be done of you...

The Feast of Unleavened Bread in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:16–19 KJV ...(17) And ye shall observe the feast of unleavened bread; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever...

The Feast of Unleavened Bread in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:16–19 KJV ...(18) In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at even, ye shall eat unleavened bread, until the one and twentieth day of the month at even....

The Feast of Unleavened Bread in the Mosaic Covenant

Exodus 12:16–19 KJV ... (19) Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses: for whosoever eateth that which is leavened, even that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he be a stranger, or born in the land.

SEVEN LEAVES

Luke 22:7–13 KJV Then came the day of unleavened bread, when the passover must be killed. (8) And he sent Peter and John, saying, Go and prepare us the passover, that we may eat. (9) And they said unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare?...

SEVEN PARTS

Luke 22:7-13 KJV ...(10) And he said unto them, Behold, when ye are entered into the city, there shall a man meet you, bearing a pitcher of water; follow him into the house where he entereth in....

The Feast of Unleavened Bread in the New Covenant.

SEVEN LEAVES

Luke 22:7-13 KJV ...(11) And ye shall say unto the goodman of the house, The Master saith unto thee, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples? (12) And he shall shew you a large upper room furnished: there make ready. (13) And they went, and found as he had said unto them: and they made ready the passover.

Sinful People in the Church As Leaven

SEVEN FEASTS

1 Corinthians 5:1–8 NKJV It is actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, and such sexual immorality as is not even named among the Gentiles—that a man has his father's wife! (2) And you are puffed up, and have not rather mourned, that he who has done this deed might be taken away from among you...

Sinful People in the Church As Leaven

SEVEN FEASTS

1 Corinthians 5:1–8 NKJV ... (3) For I indeed, as absent in body but present in spirit, have already judged (as though I were present) him who has so done this deed. (4) In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when you are gathered together, along with my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ,...

Sinful People in the Church As Leaven

SEVEN FEASTS

1 Corinthians 5:1–8 NKJV ...(5) deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus. (6) Your glorying is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump?..

SEVEN FEASTS

1 Corinthians 5:1-8 NKJV ... (7)
Therefore purge out the old leaven,
that you may be a new lump, since
you truly are unleavened. For
indeed Christ, our Passover, was
sacrificed for us...

SEVEN FEASTS

1 Corinthians 5:1–8 NKJV ... (8)
Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Sinful Doctrines in the Church As Leaven

SEVEN PARTS

Matthew 16:6-12 NKJV Then Jesus said to them, "Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees." (7) And they reasoned among themselves, saying, "It is because we have taken no bread..."

Sinful Doctrines in the Church As Leaven

SEVEN YEARS

Matthew 16:6–12 NKJV ...(8) But Jesus, being aware of it, said to them, "O you of little faith, why do you reason among yourselves because you have brought no bread? (9) Do you not yet understand, or remember the five loaves of the five thousand and how many baskets you took up?...

Sinful Doctrines in the Church As Leaven

SEVEN LEAVENS

Matthew 16:6–12 NKJV ... (10) Nor the seven loaves of the four thousand and how many large baskets you took up? (11) How is it you do not understand that I did not speak to you concerning bread?—but to beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees...."

Sinful Doctrines in the Church As Leaven

SEVEN PARTS

Matthew 16:6-12 NKJV ...(12)
Then they understood that He did not tell them to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees.

Sinful Actions in the Church As Leaven

SEVEN LEAVENS

Luke 12:1-3 NKJV In the meantime, when an innumerable multitude of people had gathered together, so that they trampled one another, He began to say to His disciples first of all, "Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy...."



DALLAS I CARTER

Sinful Actions in the Church As Leaven

SEVEN LEAVENS

Luke 12:1-3 NKJV ... (2) For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, nor hidden that will not be known. (3) Therefore whatever you have spoken in the dark will be heard in the light, and what you have spoken in the ear in inner rooms will be proclaimed on the housetops.



DALLAS I CARTER

The Mortification of Sin

Romans 6:11–18 NKJV Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord. (12) Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts...



DALLAS I CARTER

The Mortification of Sin

SEVENTEEN LESSONS

Romans 6:11–18 NKJV ...(13) And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God. (14) For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace....



DALLAS I CARTER

The Mortification of Sin

SEVEN PRINCIPLES

Romans 6:11-18 NKJV ...(15) What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under grace? Certainly not! (16) Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are that one's slaves whom you obey, whether of sin leading to death, or of obedience leading to righteousness?...

The Mortification of Sin

SEVENTEEN LEASONS

Romans 6:11–18 NKJV ...(17) But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered. (18) And having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness.
