SEVENTEEN YEARS 19

Leviticus 23:9-14 NKJV And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, (10) "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest...

The Feast of First Fruits in the Mosaic Covenant.

Leviticus 23:9-14 NKJV ...(11) He shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted on your behalf; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it. (12) And you shall offer on that day, when you wave the sheaf, a male lamb of the first year, without blemish, as a burnt offering to the LORD....

The Feast of First Fruits in the Mosaic Covenant.

SEVENTEEN YEARS

Leviticus 23:9–14 NKJV ... (13) Its grain offering shall be two-tenths of an ephah of fine flour mixed with oil, an offering made by fire to the LORD, for a sweet aroma; and its drink offering shall be of wine, one-fourth of a hin...

SEVENTEEN YEARS

Leviticus 23:9–14 NKJV ...(14) You shall eat neither bread nor parched grain, nor fresh grain until the same day that you have brought an offering to your God; it shall be a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.

SEVEN YEARS

1 Corinthians 15:19–21 NKJV If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men the most pitiable. (20) But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. (21) For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead.

SEVEN YEARS

1 Corinthians 15:50–53 NKJV Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption. (51) Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—...

The Feast of First Fruits in the New Covenant

SEVEN YEARS

1 Corinthians 15:50–53 NKJV ... (52) in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. (53) For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

Revelation 14:4 NKJV These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being firstfruits to God and to the Lamb.

Represents the Resurrection

Breakdown in the Mosaic Covenant

SEVEN YEARS

- A sheaf of the firstfruits (Lev 23:10–11)
- And you shall offer on that day, when you wave the sheaf, a male lamb of the first year, without blemish, as a burnt offering to the LORD (v 12)
- Its grain offering shall be two-tenths of an ephah of fine flour (v 13–14)



DALLAS I CARTER

Breakdown in the New Covenant

SEVEN THEMES

- Jesus, as the sheaf and very first of the firstfruits, is identified with the resurrection (1 Corinthians 15:19–21)
- Persecution of saints begins immediately after, and people pass through death to enter resurrection (1 Corinthians 15:50–53)
- The bloodless grain offering is the 144,000 raptured – changed without death (Revelation 14:4)
