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The Day of Atonement in the Mosaic Covenant

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 23:26–32 NKJV And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: (27) "Also the tenth day of this seventh month shall be the Day of Atonement. It shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire to the LORD...

The Day of Atonement in the Mosaic Covenant

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 23:26–32 NKJV ...(28) And you shall do no work on that same day, for it is the Day of Atonement, to make atonement for you before the LORD your God. (29) For any person who is not afflicted in soul on that same day shall be cut off from his people. (30) And any person who does any work on that same day, that person I will destroy from among his people..



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The Day of Atonement in the Mosaic Covenant

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 23:26–32 NKJV ...(31) You shall do no manner of work; it shall be a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings. (32) It shall be to you a sabbath of solemn rest, and you shall afflict your souls; on the ninth day of the month at evening, from evening to evening, you shall celebrate your sabbath."



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The Day of Atonement in the Mosaic Covenant

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV Now the LORD spoke to Moses after the death of the two sons of Aaron, when they offered profane fire before the LORD, and died; (2) and the LORD said to Moses: "Tell Aaron your brother not to come at just any time into the Holy Place inside the veil, before the mercy seat which is on the ark, lest he die; for I will appear in the cloud above the mercy seat...



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The Day of Atonement in the Mosaic Covenant

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(3) "Thus Aaron shall come into the Holy Place: with the blood of a young bull as a sin offering, and of a ram as a burnt offering. (4) He shall put the holy linen tunic and the linen trousers on his body; he shall be girded with a linen sash, and with the linen turban he shall be attired...



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The Day of Atonement in the Mosaic Covenant

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1-34 NKJV ... (4) ... These are holy garments. Therefore he shall wash his body in water, and put them on. (5) And he shall take from the congregation of the children of Israel two kids of the goats as a sin offering, and one ram as a burnt offering...



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The Day of Atonement in the Mosaic Covenant

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(6) "Aaron shall offer the bull as a sin offering, which is for himself, and make atonement for himself and for his house. (7) He shall take the two goats and present them before the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of meeting. (8) Then Aaron shall cast lots for the two goats: one lot for the LORD and the other lot for the scapegoat...



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A Tale of Two Goats

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1-34 NKJV ...(9) And Aaron shall bring the goat on which the LORD's lot fell, and offer it as a sin offering. (10) But the goat on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make atonement upon it, and to let it go as the scapegoat into the wilderness...



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A Bull to Atone for the High Priest

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1-34 NKJV ...(11)
"And Aaron shall bring the bull of the sin offering, which is for himself, and make atonement for himself and for his house, and shall kill the bull as the sin offering which is for himself..."



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Christ Had No need for a Bull Because He is Sinless

Hebrews 7:23-28 NKJV Also there were many priests, because they were prevented by death from continuing. (24) But He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable priesthood. (25) Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them....



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Christ Had No need for a Bull Because He is Sinless

Hebrews 7:23–28 NKJV ...(26) For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens; (27) who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's,...



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Christ Had No need for a Bull Because He is Sinless

Hebrews 7:23–28 NKJV ...(27)...for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself. (28) For the law appoints as high priests men who have weakness, but the word of the oath, which came after the law, appoints the Son who has been perfected forever.



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Incense to Cover Him from God's Wrath

SEVEN YEARS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(12) Then he shall take a censer full of burning coals of fire from the altar before the LORD, with his hands full of sweet incense beaten fine, and bring it inside the veil. (13) And he shall put the incense on the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of incense may cover the mercy seat that is on the Testimony, lest he die...



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Prayer is the Incense that Cleanses

SEVEN FEASTS

Revelation 8:1–5 NKJV When He opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. (2) And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given seven trumpets. (3) Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense,..



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Prayer is the Incense that Cleanses

SEVEN FEASTS

Revelation 8:1–5 NKJV ...(3)...that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. (4) **And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before God from the angel's hand...**



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Prayer is the Incense that Cleanses

SEVEN FEASTS

Revelation 8:1–5 NKJV ...(5) Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw it to the earth. And there were noises, thunderings, lightnings, and an earthquake.



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Prayer is the Incense that Cleanses

SEVEN FEASTS

Isaiah 6:5–7 NKJV So I said: "Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, The LORD of hosts." (6) **Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar...**



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Prayer is the Incense that Cleanses

SEVEN FEASTS

Isaiah 6:5–7 NKJV ...(7) And he touched my mouth with it, and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; **Your iniquity is taken away, And your sin purged.**"



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Cleansing the Temple

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(14) He shall take some of the blood of the bull and sprinkle it with his finger on the mercy seat on the east side; and before the mercy seat he shall sprinkle some of the blood with his finger seven times...

Cleansing the Temple

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(15) "Then he shall kill the goat of the sin offering, which is for the people, bring its blood inside the veil, do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bull, and sprinkle it on the mercy seat and before the mercy seat..

Cleansing the Temple

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(16) So he shall make atonement for the Holy Place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions, for all their sins; and so he shall do for the tabernacle of meeting which remains among them in the midst of their uncleanness...

Cleansing the Temple

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(17) There shall be no man in the tabernacle of meeting when he goes in to make atonement in the Holy Place, until he comes out, that he may make atonement for himself, for his household, and for all the assembly of Israel....



DALLAS CARTER

The Absence of People in the Temple Signifies the Atonement of the Earth

SEVEN PLAGUES

Revelation 15:7–8 NKJV Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever. (8) The temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power, and **no one was able to enter the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed.**



DALLAS CARTER

The Absence of People in the Temple Signifies the Atonement of the Earth

SEVEN PEARLS

Matthew 13:40–42 NKJV Therefore as the tares are gathered and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of this age. (41) The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will **gather out of His kingdom all things that offend** and those who practice lawlessness, (42) and will cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

Cleansing the Temple

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(18) And he shall go out to the altar that is before the LORD, and make atonement for it, and shall take some of the blood of the bull and some of the blood of the goat, and put it on the horns of the altar all around...



DALLAS CARTER

Cleansing the Temple

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(19)
Then he shall sprinkle some of the
blood on it with his finger seven
times, cleanse it, and consecrate it
from the uncleanness of the
children of Israel....



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Confession Used as Method of Cleansing

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(20) And when he has made an end of atoning for the Holy Place, the tabernacle of meeting, and the altar, he shall bring the live goat. (21) Aaron shall lay both his hands on the head of the live goat, **confess over it all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions,...**



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Confession Used as Method of Cleansing

SEVEN FEASTS

1 John 1:7–9 NKJV But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the **blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.** (8) If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (9) **If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**



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Cleansing the People

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(21)
...concerning all their sins, putting them
on the head of the goat, and shall send it
away into the wilderness by the hand of a
suitable man. (22) The goat shall bear on
itself all their iniquities to an uninhabited
land; and he shall release the goat in the
wilderness....



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Cleansing the People

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1-34 NKJV ...(23)
"Then Aaron shall come into the tabernacle of meeting, shall take off the linen garments which he put on when he went into the Holy Place, and shall leave them there..."



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Cleansing the People

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(24) And he shall wash his body with water in a holy place, put on his garments, come out and offer his burnt offering and the burnt offering of the people, and make atonement for himself and for the people....



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Final Cleanup

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(25) The fat of the sin offering he shall burn on the altar. (26) And he who released the goat as the scapegoat shall wash his clothes and bathe his body in water, and afterward he may come into the camp....



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Final Cleanup

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(27) The bull for the sin offering and the goat for the sin offering, whose blood was brought in to make atonement in the Holy Place, shall be carried outside the camp. And they shall burn in the fire their skins, their flesh, and their offal...



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Final Cleanup

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(28) Then he who burns them shall wash his clothes and bathe his body in water, and afterward he may come into the camp. (29) "This shall be a statute forever for you: In the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, you shall afflict your souls, and do no work at all, whether a native of your own country or a stranger who dwells among you....



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Final Statement of Purpose

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(30) For on that day the priest shall make atonement for you, to cleanse you, that you may be clean from all your sins before the LORD. (31) It is a sabbath of solemn rest for you, and you shall afflict your souls. It is a statute forever...



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Final Statement of Purpose

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(32) And the priest, who is anointed and consecrated to minister as priest in his father's place, shall make atonement, and put on the linen clothes, the holy garments;...



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Final Statement of Purpose

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(33) then he shall make atonement for the Holy Sanctuary, and he shall make atonement for the tabernacle of meeting and for the altar, and he shall make atonement for the priests and for all the people of the assembly....



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Final Statement of Purpose

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 16:1–34 NKJV ...(34) This shall be an everlasting statute for you, to make atonement for the children of Israel, for all their sins, once a year." And he did as the LORD commanded Moses.



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The of Atonement in the New Covenant

SEVEN YEARS

- The bull to atone the High Priest not needed for Jesus (Lev 16:11, Hebrews 7:23–28)
- The incense that covered the High Priest covered in prayer which brings cleansing (Lev 16:12–13, Revelation 8:1–5, Isaiah 6:5–7)



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The of Atonement in the New Covenant

SEVEN YEARS 13

- The dead goat that cleansed the temple represents wrath from God that cleanses the earth (Lev 16:14–19, Revelation 15:7–8, Matthew 13:40–42)
- Confession used as a method of cleansing individuals by both the live goat and through Jesus (Lev 16:20–24, 1 John 1:7–9)



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The Significance of the Day of Atonement

SEVEN FEASTS

- Cleansing from Sin
- The Removal of Sin from the earth
- What begins with sanctification ends in the wrath of God against evil as the earth's Day of Atonement



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The Significance of the Day of Atonement

SEVEN FEASTS

Romans 8:20–23 NKJV For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope; (21) because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God...



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The Significance of the Day of Atonement

SEVEN FEASTS

Romans 8:20–23 NKJV ...(22) For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now. (23) Not only that, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body.
