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The Feast of Tabernacles or Booths in the Mosaic Covenant

Leviticus 23:34–37 NKJV "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the Feast of Tabernacles for seven days to the LORD. (35) On the first day there shall be a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work on it...



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The Feast of Tabernacles or Booths in the Mosaic Covenant

Leviticus 23:34–37 NKJV "... (36) For seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation, and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. It is a sacred assembly, and you shall do no customary work on it...



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The Feast of Tabernacles or Booths in the Mosaic Covenant

Leviticus 23:34–37 NKJV "... (37) 'These are the feasts of the LORD which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire to the LORD, a burnt offering and a grain offering, a sacrifice and drink offerings, everything on its day—



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The Feast of Tabernacles or Booths in the New Covenant

Zechariah 14:16-21 NKJV And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles...



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The Feast of Tabernacles or Booths in the New Covenant

Zechariah 14:16–21 NKJV ...(17)
And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, on them there will be no rain....



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The Feast of Tabernacles or Booths in the New Covenant

Zechariah 14:16–21 NKJV ...(18) If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they shall have no rain; they shall receive the plague with which the LORD strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles....



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The Feast of Tabernacles or Booths in the New Covenant

Zechariah 14:16-21 NKJV ...(19) This shall be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. (20) In that day "HOLINESS TO THE LORD" shall be engraved on the bells of the horses. The pots in the LORD's house shall be like the bowls before the altar...



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The Feast of Tabernacles or Booths in the New Covenant

Zechariah 14:16-21 NKJV ...(21) Yes, every pot in Jerusalem and Judah shall be holiness to the LORD of hosts. Everyone who sacrifices shall come and take them and cook in them. In that day there shall no longer be a Canaanite in the house of the LORD of hosts

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 23:39-44 NKJV 'Also on the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered in the fruit of the land, you shall keep the feast of the LORD for seven days; on the first day there shall be a sabbath-rest, and on the eighth day a sabbath-rest...



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The Significance of the Feast of Tabernacles/Booths

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 23:39-44 NKJV '...(40) And you shall take for yourselves on the first day the fruit of beautiful trees, branches of palm trees, the boughs of leafy trees, and willows of the brook; and you shall rejoice before the LORD your God for seven days..



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The Significance of the Feast of Tabernacles/Booths

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 23:39-44 NKJV '...(41) You shall keep it as a feast to the LORD for seven days in the year. It shall be a statute forever in your generations. You shall celebrate it in the seventh month. (42) You shall dwell in booths for seven days. All who are native Israelites shall dwell in booths,...



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The Significance of the Feast of Tabernacles/Booths

SEVEN FEASTS

Leviticus 23:39–44 NKJV '...(43) that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.'" (44) So Moses declared to the children of Israel the feasts of the LORD.



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The Significance of the Feast of Tabernacles/Booths

SEVEN FEASTS

Exodus 13:21–22 NKJV And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so as to go by day and night. (22) **He did not take away the pillar of cloud by day or the pillar of fire by night from before the people.**



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The Significance of the Feast of Tabernacles/Booths

SEVEN FEASTS

Revelation 21:1–3 NKJV Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. (2) Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband...



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The Significance of the Feast of Tabernacles/Booths

SEVEN FEASTS

Revelation 21:1–3 NKJV ...(3) And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and **He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God.**
