Jeremiah 6:11–19 KJV...(6:12) And their houses shall be turned unto others, with their fields and wives together: for I will stretch out my hand upon the inhabitants of the land, saith the LORD. (6:13) For from the least of them even unto the greatest of them every one is given to covetousness; and from the prophet even unto the priest every one dealeth falsely...



The Warning

Jeremiah 6:11–19 KJV ...(6:14) They have healed also the hurt of the daughter of my people slightly, saying, Peace, peace; when there is no peace. (6:15) Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush: therefore they shall fall among them that fall: at the time that I visit them they shall be cast down, saith the LORD...



Walk the Old Paths

Jeremiah 6:11–19 KJV ... (6:16) Thus saith the LORD, **Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths**, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein...



Walk the Old Paths

Jeremiah 6:11–19 KJV ... (6:17) Also I set watchmen over you, saying, Harken to the sound of the trumpet. But they said, We will not hearken. (6:18) Therefore hear, ye nations, and know, O congregation, what is among them...



Walk the Old Paths

Jeremiah 6:11–19 KJV ... (6:19) Hear, O earth: behold, I will bring evil upon this people, even the fruit of their thoughts, because they have not hearkened unto my words, nor to my law, but rejected it..
